General Information

Date and Location

Aerials (AE) competitions will take place on Tuesday, February 14th and Wednesday, February 15th, 2017, at Val Saint-Côme on the Nicolas-Fontaine course. AE training will begin on Sunday, February 12, 2017.

Moguls (MO) competitions will take place on Saturday, February 18th (Single Moguls) and Sunday, February 19th (Dual Moguls) at Val Saint-Côme on the Alexandre-Bilodeau course. MO training will begin on Thursday, February 16, 2017.

The Fédération Internationale de Ski ("FIS") is sanctioning this Competition. The Organizing Committee of the event will host the competition in accordance with the FIS Freestyle Ski NorAm Cup rules.

All athletes entered in a NorAm Cup competition must hold a valid FIS License issued under the authority of their national ski association and conform to the rules in the FIS ICR Sections 203 and 204.

MO entries must be received no later than, Thursday, February 9, 2017 at 17:00.
AE entries must be received no later than Tuesday, February 7, 2017 at 17:00
