Freestyle Canada (FC) and Freestyle Ontario are pleased to invite eligible athletes to the **2020 MOGUL CANADA CUP SERIES PRES. BY TOYO TIRES** that will be held at Calabogie Peaks Resort on January 17th, 18th, and 19th, 2020. The event is sanctioned by Freestyle Canada and part of the Canada Cup Series presented by Toyo Tires. It is valued in the Canada Cup Rankings.

RULES

1. The event is sanctioned by FC and is organized by Freestyle Ontario in collaboration with Calabogie Peaks Freestyle, and Calabogie Peaks Resort.
2. Rules are based on a combination of FIS Rules and Regulations and Freestyle Canada. Canada Cup Competition Guidelines.
3. The Competition is comprised of 2 Moguls events (Single and Dual event).
4. All athletes must have a FC certified coach present with sufficient qualification for their intended manoeuvres and a Provincial Athlete Licence.
5. Athlete Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury.

FIELD SIZE, REGISTRATION, AND ELIGIBILITY

FIELD SIZE - The field size is limited to 100 athletes, with 90 domestic, and 10 foreign spots.

Female: 45 domestic and 5 foreign

Male: 45 domestic and 5 foreign

Unused spots may be transferred between genders.

REGISTRATION – Event Registration is open until January 10th, 2020, or 100 athletes. Registration will be \$225 + HST and include two (2) events, and an event T-Shirt. Canadian athletes must have a Provincial Athlete License.

ELIGIBILITY

- No eligibility criteria but coaches need to make sure athletes are ready to take on the course specifications and relative skill level. There are no age categories
- Priority Registration clause for HPAD Teams (PSO & NextGen)
- Foreign athletes must be approved by Freestyle Canada and their NSO

REFUNDS

Once an athlete is confirmed on a start list, refunds will not be issued. In the case of an injury the coach or parent must notify the registration desk, to inform that an athlete is injured and unable to ski before the Team Captains meeting the day before competition day. In this case athletes are entitled to partial refunds of up to 50% per event. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered only at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. If an event is cancelled due to weather or exceptional circumstances no refunds will be provided. (The organizing committee has already incurred all costs for the event)

EVENT FORMAT

SINGLE MOGULS - 3 round LCQ format

Final Field Size: 40% of registered entrants from each gender with a minimum of 6 athletes and a maximum of 20 athletes.

Q1: 1 run, Top 50% of Final field size advances to Final. (ex. If final cut is 20 athletes, top 10 advance from Q1)

Q2: Same run order. 1 run. Top %50 of final field size advances to finals. (If cut is 20 than top 10 advance from Q2) Athletes can use top score from either Q1 or Q2)

FINALS: (If finals field size 20) 1 Run, Top 10 from Q1 and top 10 from Q2. Q1 keep their rank 1-10 in finals





DUAL MOGULS

QUALIFICATION: Single run. FINAL: Dual format for up to 32 athletes of each gender seeded from qualifications.

COMPETITION OFFICE, BIBS, AND LIFT TICKETS

OFFICE - The competition office will be in the back of the main lodge, on the north side of the lodge. Follow the signs for Canada Cup Competition Office. **ALL PARTICIPANTS** must check-in at the competition office to confirm participation in the event and pick-up bibs. A map of the lodge is available at the end of this invitation.

BIBS - \$20.00 cash bib deposit is required. Bibs must be returned at the end of course or to the competition office in good condition. If a bib is lost or forgotten there will be an additional \$20 deposit. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring, if you need to replace your bib please ensure the onsite registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs must be worn properly for all onsite training, for the competitions and for awards ceremonies. A bio must be completed upon arrival at Competition office in order to receive a bib.

LIFT TICKETS - Competitor lift tickets will be available for **\$32.00 INCL. HST**. Competitor tickets will be available for purchase daily at the competition off in **CASH ONLY**. Volunteers will receive complimentary lift tickets and coaches will be entitled to free tickets up to a maximum of two per team.

LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the manoeuvres being performed in training and competition and is also available through Freestyle Canada when you register for your membership.
