



## **Mogul Program Head Coach**

The role of the Mogul Program Head Coach is to implement quality mogul programs for the members and guests at the Beaver Valley Ski Club. This includes full buy in to the overall Alpine Programs philosophy, hiring and training quality staff and going above and beyond member's expectations when it pertains to all aspects of recreational programming.

### **Job Duties**

Planning and implementation of entry to advanced level mogul programming

Hire staff/assistants/volunteers to support all mogul programs with a 1 – 7 staff to athlete ratio for mogul teams

Coaching with a core focus on Beaver Valley's high-performance mogul skiers for the entire year-round program including: 60 days in season with a pre-season camp to Quebec, up two trampoline sessions per week in Toronto during the off season, 4 to 6 weeks of on snow or ramp summer training

Manage the scheduling and booking of all mogul programming

Travel with athletes and act as guardian while on away camps or events

Assess and handle any issues (parents, participants etc.) that arise in the mogul programs to the best of your ability and keep the Alpine Programs Manager apprised

Create newsletter content when required (pre, in and post season) that is detailed but easy to follow

### **Skills and Competencies**

Planning and pedagogical skills develop through your Canada Freestyle certifications (minimum Competition Introduction Program ((Super Coach)) including the ability to certify inverts) and industry experience

Ability to manage the club's mogul environments and taking the lead role in all builds and rebuilds of mogul environments as required

Strong interpersonal and problem-solving skills when working with clients and staff

Strong leadership skills to role model for both the athletes and parents

Ability to manage parent inquiries on their athlete's progress

Competent computer skills

Flexibility when it comes to dealing with the fluid nature of programming days (weather, client's needs, staffing issues)

Dedication to go above and beyond a standard work day as required

Supporting the Alpine Programs Manager in other freestyle areas during down time from mogul training

### **Reporting**

Your direct report will be the Alpine Programs Manager and co-worker with the Freestyle Head Coach

### **Timeline**

The contract will consist of 1,600 hrs starting Oct 15, 2019 – Oct 15, 2020. The contract will consist of full-time hours Nov 1 – Mar 31 at the club and remote work with select days on site at Beaver Valley the remainder of the contract.

### **Compensation**

The salary will range between \$45,000 - \$60,000 per season depending on the applicant's certification and experience. The contract is inclusive of pay in lieu of vacation and statutory holiday pay entitlements, paid bi-weekly by direct deposit.
