

# TOYO CUP RANKING CRITERIA

Freestyle Canada is proud to partner with Toyo Tires in their support of our Canada Cup Series. As part of their partnership they are providing Freestyle Canada with four Toyo Cup prizes at the end of the year: two for men and two for women. The prizes will be awarded to the top combined, overall ranking on the Canada Cup Series for:

- the top female SS/BA/HP
- the top female MO/AE
- the top male SS/BA/HP
- the top male MO/AE.

This document has been created to provide the criteria and framework of the Toyo Cup Ranking systems.

This is a different ranking than the Canada Cup Rankings that are developed for individual discipline.

Background: The Canada Cup Series is our national circuit. It was created to support a competitive and sustainable domestic tour that Freestyle Canada athletes can develop their competitive skills in all of our disciplines; Moguls, Aerials, Slopestyle/Big Air and Halfpipe. It is designed primarily for athletes in the Train-to-Train (T2T) and Learn & Train to Compete (L2C/T2C) in the Can Freestyle Long Term Athlete Development system.



### **TOYO CUP WORKING COMMITTEE**

The working group is comprised of the following positions:

- FC Coordinator partnership and events
- FC Manager Sport Development
- FC High Performance Director MO/AE
- FC High Performance Director SS/BA/HP
- FC Director of competitions

Responsibilities: The Freestyle Canada Toyo Ranking committee is responsible for the ranking criteria. The members will:

- Ensure the criteria meets the needs of Toyo Tires and the Canada Cup Series.
- Assign one Freestyle Canada staff member to enter data.
- Review accuracy of the data entry.
- Communicate to the PSOs and coaches the criteria of the ranking system
- Identify the four winners:
  - Women AE/MO
  - Men AE/MO
  - Women SS/BA/HP
  - Men SS/BA/HP

### **TIMELINES:**

- The Toyo Cup rankings will be updated twice a month through the season.
- Winners will be crowned at the end of the Freestyle Canada season.
  - Winners will be notified by phone and email.
- Events used in the ranking will be from the current competition season.



### **TOYO CUP RANKINGS CRITERIA**

There will be two rankings per gender; rankings for the freestyle disciplines (MO/AE) and rankings for the Freeski disciplines (SS/BA/HP). The Toyo Freestyle Cup ranking will compare and identify the consistent top finishers in moguls and aerials, while the Toyo Freeski Cup ranking will compare and identify the consistent top finishers in slopestyle/big air and halfpipe. The criteria below explain the rules and the parameters.

#### **OVERARCHING GUIDELINES:**

- Any athlete competing in the Toyo Canada Cup Series is eligible (including NextGen athletes).
- For most disciplines, events in the Canada Cup Series will be used to calculate the Toyo Cup. For aerials and halfpipe, one NorAm will also be included in the rankings to ensure those athletes have a minimum of three results to use.
- Top 10 placings will be included for most events; in some case only the top five will be used (please refer to the place value charts).
- Each athlete will be awarded Toyo Cup placing points (for their discipline); the ranking will be calculated using the sum of each athlete's three best placings.
- The winners will be the top male and female with the highest cumulative Toyo Freestyle Cup points and Toyo Freeski Cup points on the below process
