Rules

1. The event is sanctioned by FIS and FC, and is organized by Freestyle Alberta in collaboration with Marmot Basin Ski Area.





2. Rules are based on a combination of FIS Rules and Regulations and Freestyle Canada - [Canada Cup Competition Guidelines](#)
3. The Competition is comprised of 2 Moguls events (Single and Dual event)
4. All athletes must have a FC Air 4B certified coach present.
Athlete Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury

Registration

Entry fees is \$190/single event & \$320 for both events

Registration closes March 18th, 2018

Field Size

Moguls : Maximum athletes to register is 90 + 10 spots for Foreign athletes (45 + 5 spots for Men & 45 +5 spots for women). Any unused spots will move to the other gender.

10 spots for Foreign Athletes

As a FIS event, National Championships must offer spots for Foreign athletes. If those spots are unused, they can move to Canadian allocation et may be used by eligible athletes.

- 5 women/5 men – Any unused spots will move to the other gender
- Foreign athletes must be approved by their country and Freestyle Canada
- If more than 10 Foreign athletes register, priority will be given to athletes with highest FIS points.

Eligibility

- As a FIS Event, FIS age required : 14 as January 1st in the year of the event
 - **Age Categories:** There are no age categories for this event.
- National team athletes automatically earn a spot
- Canadian athletes who have earned a NORAM spot in the current season earn a spot
- Remaining spots will be allocated based on :
 - Canada Cup Rankings following the most recent Canadian Series event
 - Club athletes who made one Finals at a Canadian Series event (singles or duals) in the previous or current year
 - Athlete must meet Can Selection MPL to be eligible
 - Injury clause could be in effect under the guidance of the individual PSO

Format

Single mogul format (MO)

Qualifications: single run

Final: 1 run. Top 40% from qualifications for each gender with a minimum of 6 athletes and a maximum of 20 athletes.





Dual Moguls Format (DM)

Qualifications: single run

Final: Dual format for up to 24 athletes of each gender seeded from qualifications. Top 8 athletes of each gender have a “bye”.

Licences

Canadian Athletes are required to have a **Can Free 4 FIS License**. International Athletes must have an active FIS license.

Race Office

Participants must check in at the Race Office located at the Best Western Inn on Wednesday March 21 (OPEN 9-6) or Thursday March 22 (OPEN 8- 3:30) to confirm participation in the event and to pick up competition bibs and submit BIO.

Coaches please provide emails at registration desk for distribution of results, schedule changes and other updates.

Bibs –

20.00 cash bib deposit is required. Bibs must be returned at the end of course or to the race office, in good condition. If a bib is lost or forgotten there will be an additional \$20 deposit. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring, if you need to replace your bib please ensure the on-site registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs **must** be worn properly for all on-site training, for the competitions and for awards ceremonies.

Lift Tickets

Complimentary passes for members of the Canadian Freestyle Ski Team and holders of CanWest passes and can be picked up at Guest services in the Marmot Daylodge.

For all other athletes competing in the competition - \$207.80 including GST for a 4-day ticket at Group Sales

COACHES: 1 complimentary coach ticket per team or per 10 athletes for both training and competition days
